



## **Member Responsibilities**

The Club holds one meeting each month, September through May, usually on a Thursday – some daytime and some nighttime meetings. In addition, we have our Annual Luncheon Meeting early in May. Our annual dues pay for the majority of the cost of these programs and speakers.

Our Program Committee does a wonderful job locating interesting and knowledgeable people to share their talents. We hope that members take advantage of as many of these meetings as possible. It is also a great way to meet new people.

Each member has a responsibility to participate on a refreshment committee (usually) one meeting per year. You will be contacted in advance by the Chairperson of the refreshment committee and will be instructed as to what is needed from you e.g., dessert, small sandwiches, beverages, etc. Additionally your assistance with set-up before and/or clean-up after the meeting is expected.

Each member will sit as a member on at least one Club committee. This ensures that the committees are large enough to get their specific task done in a timely, efficient manner and that members are active participants.

As our mission statement suggests, we are a civic organization with an eye toward conservation. Occasionally, the Club takes on a gardening project at a non-profit facility. Each member is encouraged to participate in Concord Garden Club projects, e.g. , clean-up of a public garden space or planting flowers at hospice house.

As a Club, we have raised some funds to contribute to local charities consistent with our mission. We also encourage our members to contribute to and/or help with any fund raising events we hold. Our primary fundraiser has been a basket raffle at the Art in Bloom event.
